-Please limit performance to about 5 minutes if possible.

-Please put your music on a CD. Only one track per CD. Bring your music with you on day of show. Performers should also bring back up music on original CD or on ipod or iphone. Please hold on to music until you are up to dance.

-If you like, you may also include short written introduction with only your name (First Name or Stage Name) and type of dance you will be performing for MC to read. Do not use your full first and last name.

-Dressing room is available but space is limited. Feel free to arrive in costume.

-There are two stages available for dancing, a professional sound system, stage lighting, and an MC.

- Please inform MC if you would like to be walked out to your car

-Performance, costuming and appearance must be in compliance with the rules under **WAC 314-11-050**.

-All Performers must fill out and sign the "List of Ethnic Oriental Dancers on Licensed Premise" form that is required by the Washington State Liquor Control Board. By signing this form you acknowledge that you have read and agree to abide by the terms of these guidelines. Form will be provided day of performance.

-Performers must be 21 years of age and have valid ID on person or in dressing room. ID needs to be available at all times to show Washington State Liquor Control Board Agents if requested.

-No knives, swords or sharp objects allowed in audience seating area.

-Performers are independent contractors and are not employees of Ding Howe Inc.. Performers are not covered under Ding Howe Inc.'s L&I Insurance or Employment Security Policies. Performers are responsible for filing and paying their own taxes.
